



Adding exam honor code declaration in quiz/assignment component

In the "Quiz" component and the "Assignment" component students can be required to sign an exam honor code declaration. You can choose the type of the statement: "Supervision via Zoom" or "Without supervision"

1.	Enter the exam on the course website (in a quiz or an assignment component)	
2.	In the menu on the left, click on "Add honor code declaration"	
3.	On the next page, select one of the honor code declarations according to how the exam will be performed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Declaration "Supervision via Zoom" • Declaration "Without supervision" 	
4.	Click on the "Add declaration" button	
*	Now the declaration name will be displayed in the quiz/assignment in the menu on the left	
*	When students enter the exam / assignment - the honor code will open and they will have to click "I agree" in order to start the exam.	
	<div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"> <p>In a Quiz: The honor code declaration will appear when the students enter the quiz and click on "Attempt quiz now"</p> <p>In an Assignment: The honor code declaration will appear when the students click the assignment link</p> </div>	
*	To receive a list of students who agreed/did not agree: In the quiz/assignment component > In the menu on the left, click on "Honor Code Declaration Report"	

Important to note: If you have set a component that includes an honor code declaration, and then duplicate or import the course website, the statement does not duplicate/ get imported. **It is necessary to set a declaration separately for each component in every course.**
